It has rounded wings, a short tail, and long legs. Unlike other owls, it does not hoot but instead produces a raspy hissing or shrieking

Female barn owls lay five to ten eggs at intervals of two to three days, placing them on bare surfaces in buildings, tree hollows, caves, or burrows. The eggs hatch after 32-34 days, and both parents participate in feeding the owlets. The young birds begin months old. Females frequently have two
